Adherent Member	Are (i) Primary Members <b>not fulfilling</b> the Primary Member Condition, and (ii) Ordinary Members <b>not</b> <b>fulfilling</b> the Ordinary Member condition	Adherent Members shall have no voting rights at the General Assembly or at any meeting of the association	The membership fee for Adherent Members is determined by the General Assembly upon the proposal of the Board of Directors. A distinction can be made per type of Adherent Member.	

In accordance with Article 3, Section 4, we understand that our application will be submitted to the Chairman of the Board of Directors or Secretary General of the Association and shall be approved by the Board of Directors unless it finds that the application does not meet the qualifications set forth in Section 2 of this Article.

We are equally aware that the Board of Directors shall act on each application for membership, either at a meeting or by mail ballot within ninety (90) days following receipt of the application by the Chairman of the Board of Directors or Secretary General.

Once the application is approved by the Board of Directors, to finalize the membership process, we understand that we shall immediately:



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- 1. Pay the annual membership fee for this year as indicated on the above table. In this respect, an invoice will be issued for the relevant amount calculated on a *pro rata temporis* starting from the date of membership approval, and
- 2. under the condition precedent of timely payment, have the rights as and shall assume the obligations of the selected membership type as defined and set forth in the Articles of Association.

## Membership eligibility

Membership is open to associations and individual companies having legal personality. All PET stakeholders are therefore welcome and eligible for membership, including those without legal entities in the EU, EFTA, or UK, who will be classified as **Adherent Members**. These members are involved in the following activities:

- The manufacture of PTA or ancillary chemicals used to make PET
- The manufacture of PET
- The commercial manufacturing and sale of PET articles from virgin and recycled PET
- The supply of ancillary chemicals used in the manufacture of PET Articles
- The commercial manufacture and sale of solid and liquid foodstuffs filled in PET packaging in Europe, provided that a significant volume of their products are sold in PET containers
- The commercial reclaims of post-consumer PET containers in Europe, the product of which is sold as flakes
   or pellets
- The sales of equipment used in the value chain from PET manufacture to production of recyclate
- Other activities with prevailing interest in PET

Membership will have to be approved by the Board of Directors. The Board will act on each application for membership within ninety days following receipt of the application.
