

Situation and challenges for the Plastics Recycling Industry

SRP – Syndicat national des Régénérateurs de matières Plastiques (France) – French National Union of Plastic Material Recyclers

Represents over 85% of plastic waste recycling capacity in France.

Key figures for 2024

- > 623,560 tons of recycled plastics produced by SRP members.
- ➤ +9.2% growth compared to 2023 (constant perimeter).

Main industrial sectors supplied: Packaging: 47%, Construction: 18% and Automotive: 11%

PET Production in 2024

- ➤ R-PET Pellets: 119,704 tonnes (-18%)
- > R-PET Flakes: 139,731 tonnes (+55%)



STP Market Situation

- > Imports rising, prices falling: EU recyclers operating below capacity.
- > Production 2024 = only 2/3 of SRP members' total capacity.
- > Several facilities shut down or investments halted in France in 2024. Same situation at EU level.
- Without swift EU action: risk of mass closures and job losses across Europe.



Boosting Circular Plastics Economy in the EU

- Set and maintain ambitious EU recycling & recycled content targets
- → Builds market confidence, stimulates demand and investment.
- Promote eco-modulation in EPR schemes to reward the use of local EU-sourced recycled plastics.
- **❖** Support local recycling & innovation
- → Invest in infrastructure, improve recyclate quality & traceability.
- Encourage eco-design
- → Facilitate product recyclability from the start.



Ensuring Fair Competition for EU Recycled Plastics

- **❖** Impose high environmental and safety standards for imports
 - → Imported recycled materials must meet EU-level requirements.
- **❖** Implement mirror measures in EU legislation & controls
 - → Fair regulatory alignment between EU and non-EU producers.
- Strengthen verification and enforcement
 - → Solid third party certification for recyclates, including imports.
- → Develop testing methods to verify recycled content & detect restricted substances.
